

# The Blessings of Yah Belong to Israel

**Shalom Family, let's dive into this topic together and see what the Word of Yah reveals.**

From the beginning, Yahuah established His covenant promises with Abraham and his descendants. These blessings were not scattered to all nations without condition, but were entrusted to Israel. If we want to share in the blessings of Yah, we must understand where they are rooted and how we must enter into covenant to partake in them.

## 1. Blessings First Given to Israel

In the Torah and the Prophets, the blessings (covenants, land, promises) were given to Israel which are Abraham's descendants through Isaac and Jacob.

Deuteronomy 28 lays out blessings for obedience and curses for disobedience, these were addressed to Israel.

Psalms 147:19–20 says YHWH gave His statutes and judgments to Israel, “He has not dealt so with any nation.”

The blessings, whether land, covenant, or promises, were not given to the nations, but to Israel.

## 2. The Church and the Grafting In

In the New Testament, Paul explains that the nations (Gentiles) are not separate but grafted into Israel's tree through Yahshua.

Romans 11:17 — Gentile believers are like wild branches grafted into Israel's olive tree.

Ephesians 2:12–13 — Gentiles were once “strangers from the covenants of promise,” but in Messiah they are “brought near.”

Yahshua Himself said: “I was sent only to the lost sheep of the house of Israel” (Matthew 15:24).

The blessings flow from Israel outward, not the other way around.

## 3. One People, Not Two

The Bible doesn't teach two separate peoples (Israel vs. the church). It teaches one flock under one Shepherd.

John 10:16 — “And other sheep I have, which are not of this fold: them also I must bring, and they shall hear My voice; and there shall be one fold, and one shepherd.”

Galatians 3:29 — “If you are Messiah's, then you are Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise.”

This means true faith in Yahshua joins you to Israel. You are no longer a stranger but part of the covenant family.

## **Conclusion**

The blessings of Yah are not divided, they were given to Israel, and through Yahshua, anyone who believes and obeys becomes part of Israel's covenant family.

The church does not replace Israel, it is joined to Israel. To share in the blessings, we must become part of Yah's covenant people, guard His commands, and abide in Yahshua the Messiah.

The blessings of Yah belong to Israel. And if you belong to Messiah, you belong to Israel too and you must do as Israel was commanded to do.
