

What's Your Sign? A Biblical Look at Zodiac Signs

Shalom Family, let's dive into this topic together and see what the Word of Yah reveals.

When someone asks, "What's your sign?" they're talking about the zodiac. The zodiac claims that the position of the stars and planets at your birth determines your personality, emotions, and destiny. Many people read horoscopes for guidance, identity, or even comfort.

But Scripture paints a very different picture. YHWH warns us not to look to the stars for answers, but to Him and His Spirit. Let's see what the Torah, the Prophets, and the New Testament say about it.

The Torah: A Clear Warning

- Deuteronomy 4:19 – "And beware, lest you lift up your eyes to heaven, and when you see the sun and the moon and the stars... you be drawn away and bow down to them and serve them."
- Deuteronomy 18:10–12 – Divination, fortune-telling, and interpreting omens are called abominations to YHWH.
- Leviticus 19:26 – "You shall not practice divination or soothsaying."

In Torah, YHWH makes it clear: do not turn to the heavens for guidance.

The Prophets: Exposing Astrologers

- Isaiah 47:13–14 – YHWH mocks Babylon's astrologers: "Let your astrologers come forward, those stargazers who make predictions month by month... Surely they are like stubble; the fire will burn them up."
- Jeremiah 10:2 – "Do not learn the way of the nations or be terrified by signs in the heavens."

The Prophets show that astrology has no power to save and is worthless before YHWH.

The New Testament: Spirit vs. Fleshly Signs

- Acts 7:42 – Israel was judged for worshiping “the host of heaven.”
- Galatians 4:9–10 – Paul rebukes believers for going back to observing “days, months, seasons, and years” (astrological cycles).
- Colossians 2:8 – “See to it that no one takes you captive by philosophy and empty deceit, according to human tradition... and not according to Messiah.”

The New Testament confirms: our guidance must come from the Holy Spirit, not stars or human traditions.

What Zodiac Signs Claim to Do

Zodiac signs claim to:

- Shape your personality (e.g., “You’re bold because you’re an Aries”).
- Determine your relationships (e.g., “Virgo and Leo don’t mix”).
- Guide your future (through horoscopes and predictions).

But here’s the problem: that puts your identity in creation, not the Creator.

The True Sign: The Holy Spirit

The Spirit of YHWH does everything people look for in zodiac signs, but in truth and righteousness:

- Shapes Our Character – “But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control.” (Galatians 5:22–23)
- Guides Our Decisions – “I will instruct you and teach you in the way you should go.” (Psalm 32:8)
- Gives Us Identity – “For those who are led by the Spirit of Elohim are the children of Elohim.” (Romans 8:14)

Instead of asking “What’s your sign?” we should ask:

“Am I walking in the Spirit of YHWH?”

Zodiac signs promise identity, guidance, and destiny, but they are empty lies rooted in divination. Torah forbids them, the Prophets expose their weakness, and the New Testament calls us to live by the Spirit.

Your “sign” is not written in the stars. It’s written in heaven, sealed by the Holy Spirit.

Until we meet again, may we continue to walk in the undeniable truth of Yah’s Word.
