Our Vision

We envision a thriving generation of young leaders—spiritually rooted, purpose-driven, and practically equipped—who rise to bless their communities and nations with Kingdom values and make an impact in every sphere of society with love, passion and God ideas. Like the oasis of En Gedi, our school is meant to be a place of refreshment, renewal, growth, and divine encounters.

Our Curriculum

The "Greenhouse of En Gedi" curriculum is designed to guide participants through a three-trimester journey focused on holistic spiritual growth and practical application of faith in everyday life. The curriculum is structured around the core principles of loving oneself, loving God, and loving one's neighbor.

Trimester Breakdown

- **Trimester 1: Love yourself: Identity and Intimacy**
 - Focuses on establishing a strong identity in Jesus, understanding one's calling, dealing with negative mindsets (such as slave, orphan, or victim mentalities), and developing intimacy with the Father, Jesus, and the Holy Spirit.
- **Trimester 2: Love God: God, the Kingdom and the Supernatural**
 - Explores the nature of God's Kingdom, the importance of the supernatural in Christian life, and how the Bible serves as a handbook for encountering God and trusting in His goodness, even amidst disappointment.
- **Trimester 3: Love your neighbor: Go in all the world!**
 - Addresses practical application, including developing one's calling and gifts, entrepreneurship (how to start a business with the Holy Spirit's guidance), understanding end-times theology with hope, and cultivating a **culture of honor** in leadership and relationships.
