Our Curriculum

The "Greenhouse of En Gedi" curriculum is designed to guide participants through a three-trimester journey focused on holistic spiritual growth and practical application of faith in everyday life. The curriculum is structured around the core principles of loving oneself, loving God, and loving one's neighbor.
