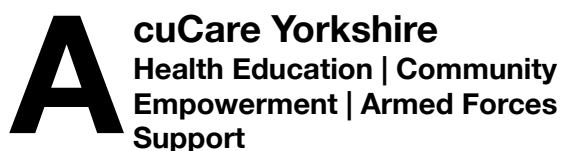

- Exploring funding opportunities to expand free or subsidised training for low-income families, care providers, and Forces communities
- Maintaining robust quality assurance through continuous professional development, learner feedback systems, and external accreditation review
