## VARSITY INCUBE GAMECHANGERS FOUNDATION 2025 EXECUTIVE LEADERSHIP ELECTIONS ELECTORAL CODE OF CONDUCT

The Varsity InCube GameChangers Foundation Electoral Code of Conduct aims to promote conditions that are conducive to free and fair elections and to foster a culture of tolerance, accountability, and open dialogue among members.

All **nominations** submitted must be accompanied by a signed **undertaking** binding each candidate to the provisions of this Code. Failure to comply may result in the **disqualification** of a candidate from the Foundation's elections.

The External Electoral Scrutineers (EES), appointed by the Foundation's leadership, are mandated to oversee the integrity of the elections and to **publish an Electoral Code of Conduct** that guides the conduct of campaigning, canvassing, and election procedures.

## Promotion of the Code, Compliance, Commitment, and Cooperation

All candidates are bound by this Code and are expected to:

- Promote the goals and values of the Code during their campaigns.
- Publicise it responsibly among members.
- Support efforts to educate voters about the election process.

Candidates must also encourage their supporters to respect this Code and publicly affirm that all members have the right to:

- a) Freedom of expression and opinion.
- b) Engage in open dialogue and constructive debate.
- c) Distribute election and campaign materials.
- d) Display banners, posters, or other campaign materials respectfully.
- e) Canvass for support and recruit members.
- f) Hold public meetings and discussions related to the elections.

Candidates must **publicly condemn any act** that undermines the fairness or integrity of the election process.

They must **accept the election results** or challenge them only through the procedures outlined in the Foundation's Constitution.

## **Prohibited Conduct**

Candidates are strictly prohibited from:

- a) Using language or actions that incite hostility, intimidation, or conflict.
- b) Spreading false, misleading, or defamatory information.
- c) Copying or misusing another candidate's identity, material, or emblem.
- d) Discriminating against any person based on race, gender, religion, class, or background.

No person is permitted to:

- a) Carry weapons or objects that may threaten safety.
- b) Prevent others from reasonably accessing members for campaign or communication purposes.
- c) Remove, deface, or destroy another candidate's campaign material.

In addition to this Code of Conduct, the **internal rules**, **values**, **and policies of the Varsity InCube GameChangers Foundation** shall be applicable and take precedence in all election-related matters.
