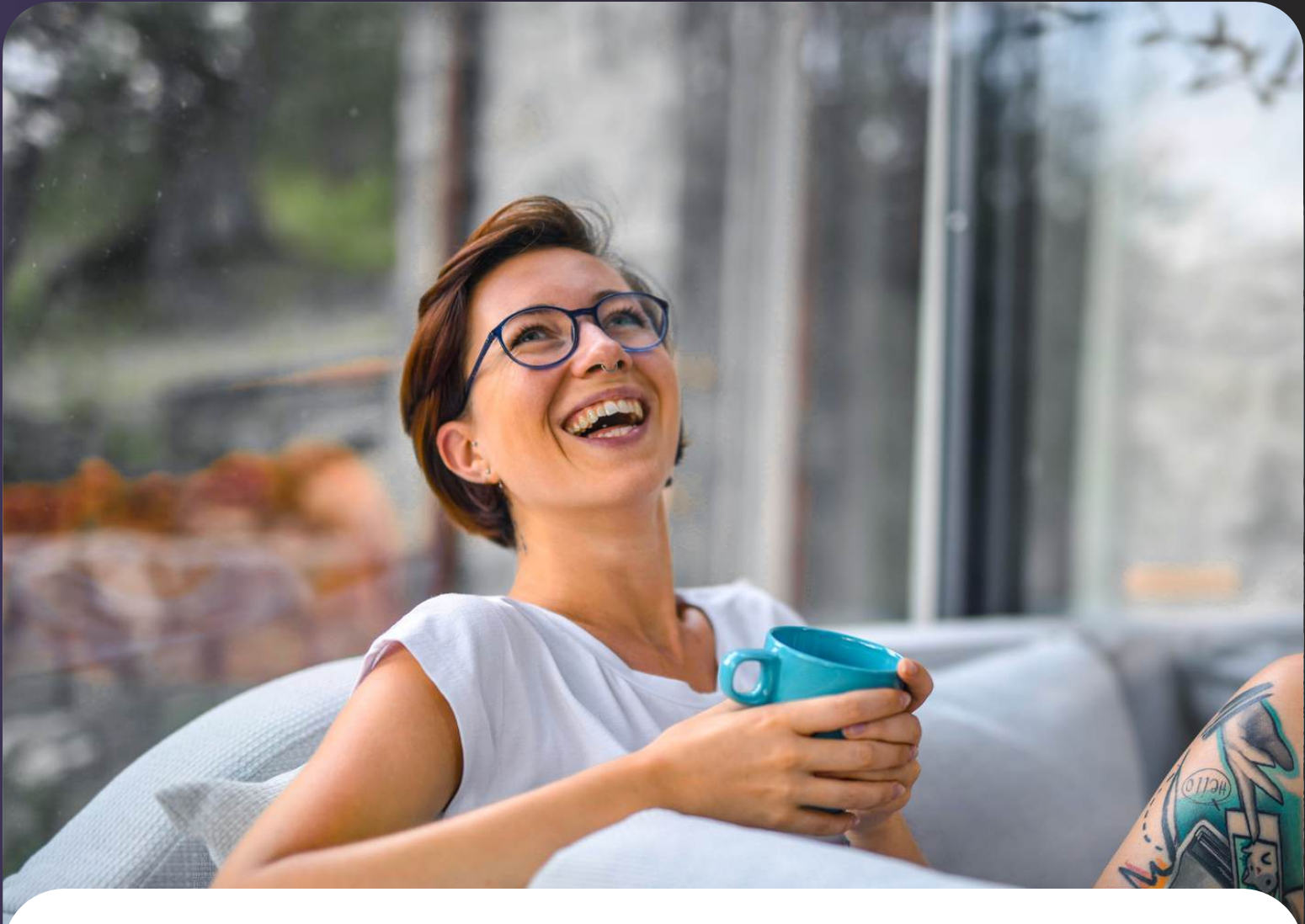

Week 1: Inviting in Ancestral Wisdom

Friday, May 2, 2025 – Podcast Snippet (Video)

Episode: Awakening the Divine Feminine, Mastering Discernment, The Power of Self-Love, Reconnecting with Your Calling

Question: What rituals anchor you when you feel untethered from your truth?

It’s about speaking the unspeakable, not to harm—but to heal.

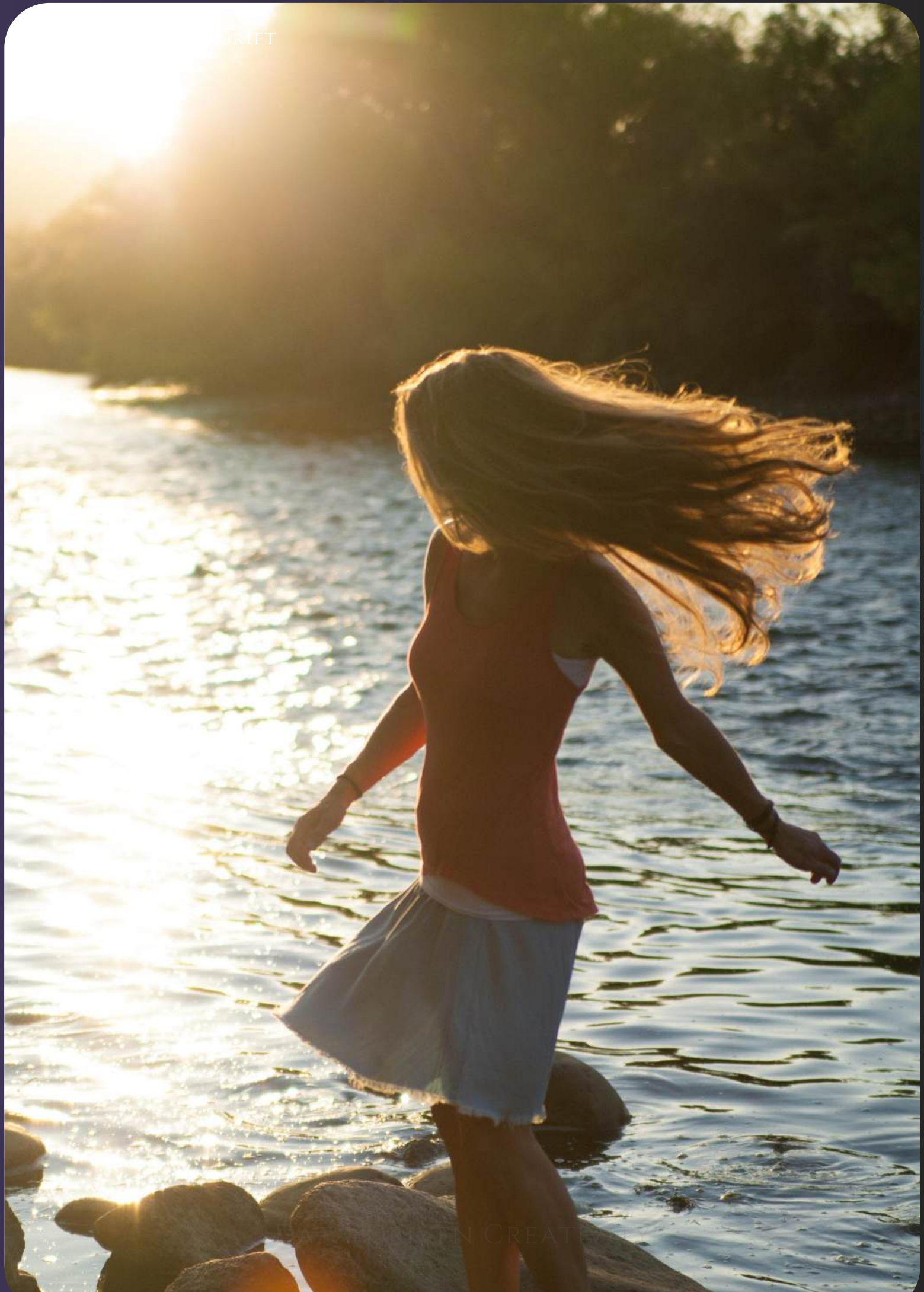
