- The winner and 9 runners-up will be selected by the jury and notified by e-mail.
- The jury's decision is final and not subject to negotiation.
- Works must be derived from analog or digital photography. Content generated by AI cannot be the source of the entry.
- The Festival FlamencA recognizes you as the author of the image, and you retain full ownership of the copyright for each of your entries.
- In the event that you are a finalist, you confirm that your credited image may be included on the Festival FlamencA website and in all Festival communication materials.
- All entrants must be able to provide a high-resolution image suitable for printing on fine art paper, if selected.
- The winners will be announced online on Thursday June 06, 2025.
