## 1. What Are Cookies?

---

Cookies are small text files stored on your device (computer, tablet, or smartphone) when you visit a website. They help ensure proper website functionality, remember your preferences, and provide information about how the website is used.

## 2. Types of Cookies We Use

---

### a) Strictly Necessary Cookies

These cookies are essential for the operation of the website and cannot be disabled. They enable core functions such as session management, security, and form submission. No consent is required for these cookies (legitimate interest basis under GDPR Art. 6(1)(f)).

### b) Functional Cookies

These cookies remember your preferences and settings (e.g., language selection) to improve your experience. They are activated only with your prior consent.

### c) Analytical Cookies

If implemented in the future, analytical cookies would help us understand how visitors interact with the website. Any such cookies would be used only with your explicit prior consent. UnivArtis does not currently use third-party analytics tools (such as Google Analytics).

## 3. Third-Party Cookies

---

UnivArtis may use third-party payment processors (PayU, PayPal, Wise) that may set their own cookies strictly for transaction processing. These providers operate under their own privacy policies. UnivArtis does not use US-based marketing, advertising, or tracking tools.

## 4. Managing Cookie Preferences

---

You can manage or withdraw your cookie consent at any time:

- Via the cookie banner/consent manager displayed on your first visit
- Via your browser settings (you can delete or block cookies at any time)

Disabling strictly necessary cookies may affect website functionality.

## 5. Legal Basis

---

- Strictly necessary cookies: legitimate interest (Art. 6(1)(f) GDPR) – no consent required
- Functional and analytical cookies: user consent (Art. 6(1)(a) GDPR) – consent required before placement

In accordance with the EU ePrivacy Directive, cookies requiring consent are placed only after the user actively accepts them via the consent banner.

## 6. Data Retention via Cookies

---

Session cookies are deleted when you close your browser. Persistent cookies remain for a defined period (typically 12 months or less) or until manually deleted.

## 7. Cookie Banner

---

On your first visit to the website, you will see a cookie consent banner allowing you to accept all cookies, reject non-essential cookies, or manage your preferences individually.
