# CLONING AGENTS LURK IN SHADOWS

If you get cold, blank stares or the person's eyes shift rapidly back-and-forth, you are most likely dealing with an agent and not a human entity.

Say something to others around you and make an escape if you have to. Tell the owner of the space. Most people don't want their guests to feel uncomfortable or be subject to agent energy collectors and will likely take action.



city of Nonsville and beyond."


Lora Neebmi, 14,
