I choose this picture because it reminds me of **LOVE**, the most important principle of my teaching philosophy. I must love my career, I must love my students, or otherwise I cannot be a good teacher no matter how knowledgeable or well-educated I am.

The little lanterns in the low left corners represent our **short-term goals** while the bit one on the right in the middle represents our **long-term goal**. Each day I help my students to focus on fulfilling our short-term goals and keep the long-term goal in my mind. By the end of the year, the long-term goal will be able to achieve because we each day focus on our short-term goals and fulfill them.

The blue sign with an arrow on in the right bottom represents the **direction** of our classroom. The traffic lights in the lower middle toward right side represent the classroom **rules**. The leaves surrounding the heart represent the **contents** and the heart again here also represents the **objectives** of the content. We start each class from the **objectives** and end up with the **objectives**.
