FRACTIONS

What are Fractions?

Fractions are a way to represent part of a whole.

They show a portion of a quantity, divided into equal parts.

In the fraction 1/4, 1 is the numerator and 4 is the denominator. A fraction has two parts, numerator and denominator.


How can we use Fractions in the real world?


Fractions are all around us!Here are some cool ways we use fractions in the real world:


Cooking: When you're baking cookies, a recipe might say 1/2 cup of sugar. That means you need half of a cup!


Pizza: Imagine you're sharing a pizza with friends. If you eat 1/4 of the pizza, that means you've eaten one quarter of the whole pizza!


