## Nashik Red Onion

Nashik Red Onion is known for its sharp pungency, deep red color, and firm texture. Grown in the fertile soils of Maharashtra, it offers a longer shelf life, making it ideal for international exports and bulk storage.

Fresh export-grade okra is tender, vibrant green, and 8–12 cm in length. It is handpicked and packed to preserve texture and freshness, widely demanded in the Middle East and Southeast.


