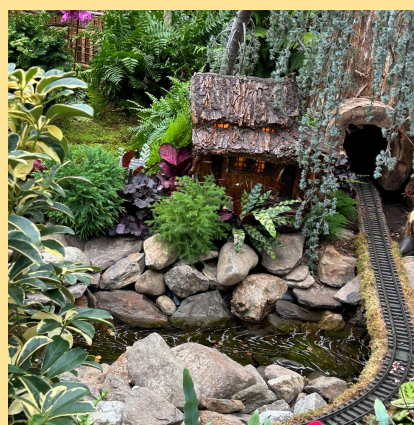


District X Digest

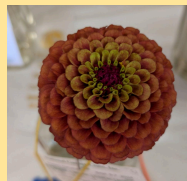
Flower Show School- April 1-3 2025
