Strumming Pattern: d du udu

*Sleigh bells lead in (if available)*

[C] Dashing through the snow, In a [C] one horse open [F] sleigh  
[F] Over the hills we [G] go, Laughing all the [C] way  
[C] Bells on Bobtails ring, [C] Making spirits [F] bright  
What [F] fun it is to [G] ride and sing, A sleighing song to- [C/] night [/G] Oh

### Chorus

[C] Jingle Bells, jingle Bells, [C] jingle all the way  
[F] Oh what fun it [C] is to ride in a [Dm] One horse open [G7] sleigh  
[C] Jingle bells, jingle Bells, [C] jingle all the way  
[F] Oh what fun it [C] is to ride in a [G] one Horse open [C] sleigh

A [C] day or two ago, I [C] thought I'd take a [F] ride  
And [F] soon, Ms Fanny [G] Bright, Was seated by my [C] side  
The [C] horse was lean and lank, mis- [C] fortune seemed his [F] lot  
He [F] got into a [G] drifted bank, And then we got up- [C/] sot [/G] Oh

### Chorus

[C] Now the ground is white, [C] go it while you're [F] young  
[F] Take the girls to- [G] night, and sing this sleighing [C] song  
Just [C] get a bobtailed bay, two [C] forty as his [F] speed
