**Topic:** Act 80 Successor Blood Quantum

SCHHA is conducting this HBA Consultation to document the views of Homestead Beneficiary Associations (HBAs) defined in **43 CFR Part 48.6** and is accepting testimony from all others including HHCA Beneficiaries, Native Hawaiians, and the General Public.

Before Act 80 can become law, 43 CFR Part 48 requires the U.S. Department of Interior (DoI) analyze the amendment, and forward Act 80 with DoI recommendations to the U.S. Congress committees of jurisdiction for consent, specifically, the Senate Committee on Energy/Natural Resources and the House Committee on Natural Resources. This SCHHA HBA Consultation is conducted to advance a determination by the DoI on Act 80 under the 43 CFR Part 48 regulatory process.
