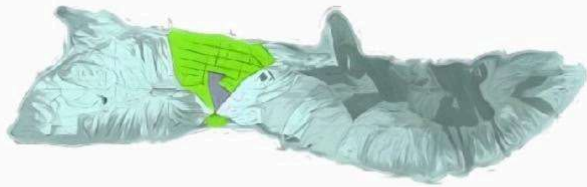

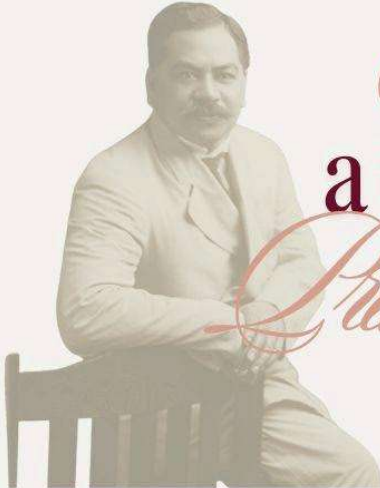

ARTICLE III – MEMBERSHIP

Section 3.1 Eligibility for Membership. Members of Ho'olehua Homesteaders Association shall be lessees and/or spouses and/or the adult child(ren) and/or extended 'ohana members living on Ho'olehua Hawaiian homestead lands; and/or a Ho'olehua Hawaiian homestead waitlister and their successors or awardee. If there is more than one family unit in a household (i. e. lessee & spouse is one family unit, lessee's adult child is another family unit), additional family unit(s) living on the homestead may apply for separate membership. Membership application requires completion of an application and the payment of annual dues.

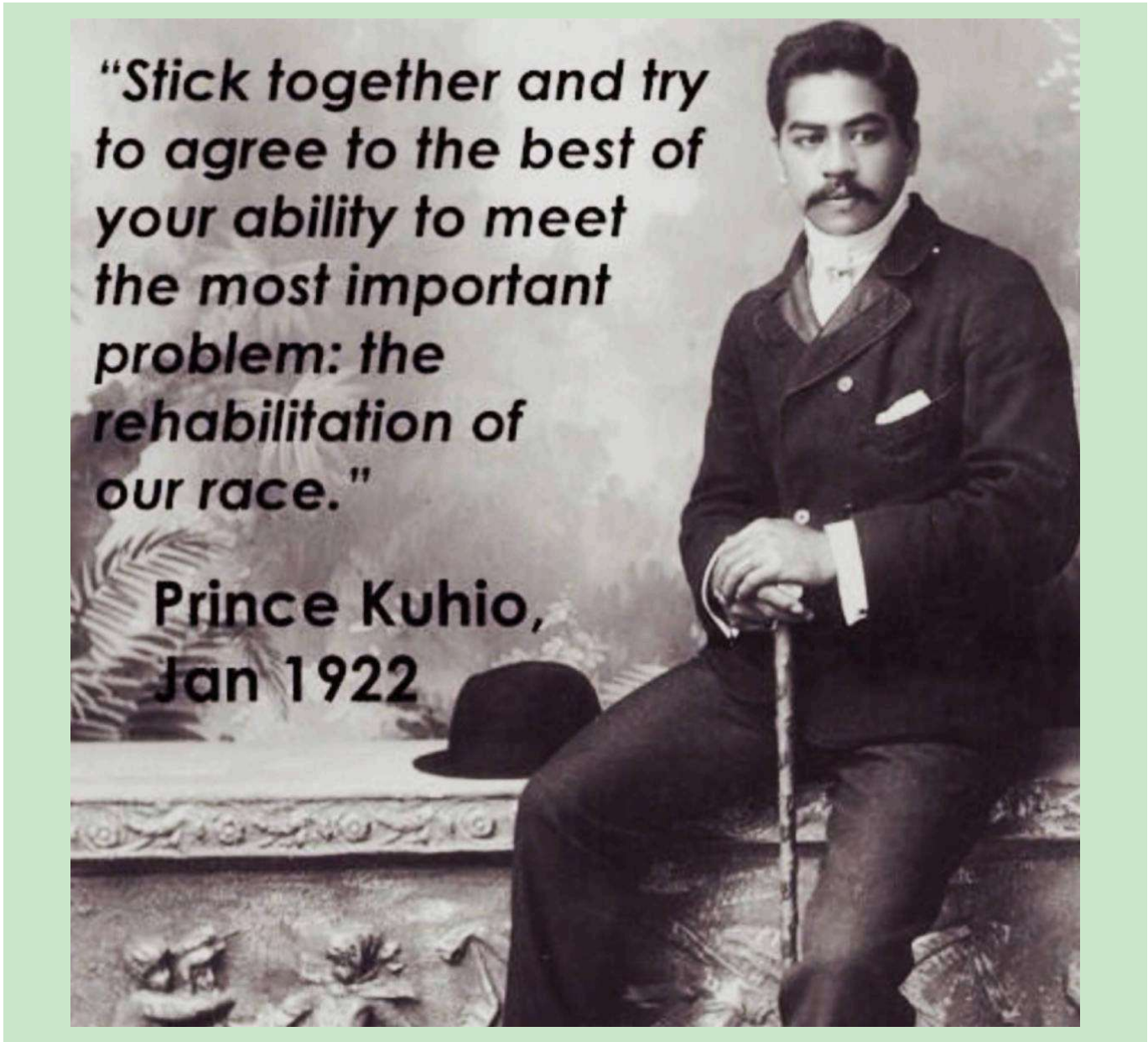
