Up to \$25,000 grant to Maui County small farmers and ranchers. Many of our HHA members received grants last year.

For farms less than 12 acres and livestock ranches up to 40 acres.

Must have GE license as of July 1, 2024. Preference given to women and Native Hawaiians.

Grants may be used to directly impact the availability of locally-grown produce, livestock and poultry and other related products. Funds can be used for:

- Farming equipment and machinery.
- · Processing and storage equipment.
- · Farm infrastructure, expansion and upgrades.
- Inventory and supplies.
- Packaging and materials.
- Technology equipment.

Gather your documents:

- Completed application.
- · Farm Needs Statement.
- Farm Business Plan (startup farm)
- Copy of an original general excise tax license or filed form G-45 or G-49.
- · Photo ID.
- 2023 state tax form N-11 (proof of residency).

ARTICLE III - MEMBERSHIP

Section 3.1 Eligibility for Membership. Members of Hoʻolehua Homesteaders Association shall be lessees and/or spouses and/or the adult child(ren) and/or extended 'ohana members living on Hoʻolehua Hawaiian homestead lands; and/or a Hoʻolehua Hawaiian homestead waitlister and their successors or awardee. If there is more than one family unit in a household (i. e. lessee & spouse is one family unit, lessee's adult child is another family unit), additional family unit(s) living on the homestead may apply for separate membership. Membership application requires completion of an application and the payment of annual dues.


