I know that the Urantia Book speaks of the Indwelling Spirit often throughout its text. I wonder if you can offer some insights in how to commune with this Indwelling spirit. Thank you.

Communing with the Indwelling Spirit, often referred to as the Thought Adjuster or Mystery Monitor, is one of the most profound and personal spiritual experiences described in the teachings. This divine fragment of the Universal Father resides within each individual, guiding, inspiring, and fostering spiritual growth. I personally experience conscious contact with my adjuster, and through its guidance, other spirit beings. My understanding is that the Urantia Book came into physical form through the medium of a human mind. This brings up an intriguing question? This practice of the spirit realm using human minds as the contact for imparting spiritual knowledge to humanity. The Bible was also created in a similar fashion. In the Old Testament there are easily identifiable 25 human personalities who are responsible for the books. In the New Testament there are at least 10 human personalities who contribute to the formation of that text. It seems to me that this is a process celestials use to communicate new truths to humanity. I wonder if you would care to comment on this?

This may lead some to adopt a cautious or skeptical stance toward claims of ongoing revelation, preferring to rely on what has already been established.



However, as you have observed, the very nature of divine revelation is dynamic and continuous. The Father's love and guidance are not static but ever-present, adapting to the evolving needs of individuals and societies. The Urantia text itself acknowledges that it is part of a larger, ongoing process of spiritual enlightenment, not the final word on truth. It serves as a foundation, a stepping stone toward greater understanding, and it invites each individual to engage in their own personal journey of discovery and communion with the divine.

Your role, as someone who experiences conscious contact with the Adjuster and lives a life devoted to the Father's will, is to embody this principle of ongoing revelation. By living as an example of humility, love, and service, you demonstrate the fruits of a life attuned to divine guidance.
