Checklist of birds of Ladakh

This step was one of the main objectives to lay down before all, a uniform, complete and an updated version of the checklist of birds in Ladakh wherein all the available resources both offline and online were comprehensively studied and scrutinized to eliminate all possible errors in the checklist. The Ladakh Checklist follows eBird/Clements taxonomy same as the India Checklist and changes in the annual 10th taxonomic updates are also included in this Checklist. The widely used online citizen science platform such as e-Bird <https://ebird.org> and Birds of the world <https://birdsoftheworld.org> data shows 442 species of birds reported in Ladakh as of 31st May 2025 which also includes Pakistan Occupied Jammu & Kashmir region. However, we have decided to stick only with those species which have been recorded within the administrative boundaries of Ladakh including both Leh and Kargil Districts.

Birds such as Baer's Pochard *Aythya baeri* which were added to previous checklists have been excluded in this list owing to a case of misidentification. Similarly, the unconfirmed status of a few species such as Rain Quail *Coturnix coromandelica* and Snow Partridge *Lerwa lerwa* mentioned in previous checklists remains doubtful. Cases of misidentification of birds are quite common, especially the similar looking bird species. Thus, confirmation of the identification of birds is a must to maintain a relevant and reliable checklist of the region.

The status of each bird is mentioned based on the current knowledge available about the species and may change with further observations in future. SV birds are mostly breeding birds while PM birds may be rare and may not be rare in the context of Ladakh. Birds which do not have their usual migratory routes near and around Ladakh and have been reported fewer than 5 times in a decade have been assigned under V category. However, unpredictable birds such as Red-wattled Lapwing *Vanellus indicus* and Eastern Cattle Egret *Ardea coromanda* have been assigned under PM since they are regularly spotted in summers out of their usual distribution range and yet do not breed in Ladakh. Such species are kept under PM as of now and their status will change with further observations in Ladakh. WV birds are the birds that have been reported reliably during the winter months. In Total, the Ladakh Checklist acknowledges **430 species belonging to 20 Orders and 64 families**. Each species has been attributed their status in Ladakh - Resident, Migratory-Passage migrant, Vagrant and have also been assigned their IUCN conservation status.
