

SHOW PROSPECTUS / ENTRY RULES

ELIGIBILITY:

This is an open show with no media categories, artist's original works only. Works previously exhibited in T FAG Spring Art Shows are prohibited. Only artwork completed in the last two years is eligible for competition. Artwork from published photographs, workshops, classwork or copies of another artist's work will not be accepted as well as computer generated art, giclee prints, prints, frontal nudes, objectionable subjects and crafts.

Prior to the judging, the Screening Committee reserves the right to reject any work submitted. Outside dimensions of any entry can be no larger than 36" by 48" with minimal frame. Gallery wrapped canvas paintings must be of 3/4 inch thickness or more.

ENTRY FEE:

\$45.00 per member or \$60.00 per non-member . Registration fee is for 1 to 4 artworks not to exceed 4 combined. Entry fees for rejected works of art will not be refunded.

MEDIA:

Paintings in oils, acrylics, watercolors, mixed media, collage, batik, pastel, pen & ink, charcoal, pencil and Photography. Freestanding small-scale sculpture weighing 20 pounds or less and not extending 24" in any direction. Original hand-built or wheel-thrown pottery will be accepted.

PREPARATION:

All Works must be properly framed, wired and ready for hanging. **SAW TOOTH HANGERS ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE.** Watercolors, pastels and works on paper and Photography must be covered with glass or plexiglass for protection. **WET ARTWORK WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**
