This year, the Annual Culloden Commemoration coincides with Easter Weekend.

The events begin on the Friday afternoon with the Christopher Duffy Memorial Lecture, sponsored this year by the 1745 Association.

We are delighted to offer a lecture by **Professor David Purdie** MD FRCP Ed. FRSSA, Honorary Fellow of the Institute for Advanced Studies in the Humanities, University of Edinburgh.

The lecture will tell the story of the three surgeons who were part of the Prince's Army in the campaign of 1745-46; who they were, their part in the rising and what became of them afterwards.



Many will know of Dr. Archibald Cameron, the last Jacobite to suffer the ultimate penalty for his loyalty to the House of Stuart; this lecture will broaden your knowledge of Dr. Archie and his colleagues in a fascinating telling of their stories – and something for followers of the game of golf as well!
