Single Family Residential Checklist

Construction of a single family residence on the above noted block and lot requires a Soil Erosion & Sediment Control permit. The items listed below are requirements of the Soil Erosion & Sediment Control permit and must be followed. Read each item below and write your initials on the line acknowledging your understanding of the requirement.

- _____ 1. Sediment Barriers will be properly installed in accordance with the Single Family Soil Erosion & Sediment Control (SESC) plan
- _____ 2. A Stabilized Construction Entrance (stone tracking pad) is required at the lot entrance. Refer to the Single Family SESC plan
- _____ 3. Paved roadways must be kept clean at all times. Any soil tracked onto a paved roadway must be removed immediately.
- _____ 4. The Cumberland Salem Conservation District must be notified in writing 48 hours prior to the start of this project. This can be emailed to info@cumberlandsalem.org
- _____ 5. The soil erosion permit package must be maintained on site during the project.
- _____ 6. Additional guidelines and forms can be found on the District website noted above
- _____ 7. The project is subject to the Standard for Land Grading. The Soil Decompaction Testing Requirements must be followed including submission of verification form. Completed form must be returned to the District prior to scheduling a Report of Compliance Inspection.
- _____ 8. All soil disturbed during this project must be stabilized (seed, mulch layer & mulch anchoring or established turf grass) in order to be eligible for a Report of Compliance. Bare soil and/or weeds are not acceptable.
- _____ 9. A Report of Compliance must be scheduled with the District one week in advance and must be obtained BEFORE the project is eligible for a Certificate of Occupancy.
- _____ 10. Failure to follow the Soil Erosion & Sediment Control permit requirements will result in additional Inspection charges & Non-Compliance Fees which must be paid prior to obtaining a Report of Compliance.

I am the Applicant for this soil erosion permit and have read and understand the above noted requirements. Failure to follow the requirements outlined in the Standards for Soil Erosion and Sediment Control in New Jersey and my Soil Erosion and Sediment Control Permit will delay the issuance of a Report of Compliance and therefore delay my Certificate of Occupancy.
