

Number Pairs Game

How to play:

Print out the sheets and stick them to card before cutting them out. You can choose the number pairs you want to include.

The sheets can be laminated only if they're printed on thick paper so the ink is not visible on the reverse.

Mix the cards up and lay them on the table, face down.

Players take turns to pick up two cards. If the cards are a number match the player keeps the cards and has another turn.

If the words on the cards don't show the same number the player replaces them and the next player has their turn.

Players should be encouraged to say the number aloud as they look at the card.

Once all the cards are collected by the players, the player with the most pairs wins.
