

# Sounds Jigsaw Pictures

## How to use:

Print out the sheets and cut the page so each picture is separate.

(The sheets can be laminated or stuck to card first, but this isn't necessary.)

Cut each picture along the dotted lines. The number of pieces will match the number of sounds in that word.

Give the child the pieces of cut up picture and ask them to put the pieces together so the picture is complete. Now ask them to tell you the sounds in the word, pointing to a different piece of the picture each time they say a sound.

You can tell the child what the picture is first, or let them work it out as they make the picture. You will probably have to tell them 'street' as this picture could be of a town, houses etc. but it matches the number of sounds in 'street'.

## The words and sounds are:

sock /s/ /o/ /ck/

bread /b/ /r/ /e/ /d/

house /h/ /ow/ /s/

snake /s/ /n/ ai/ /k/

leaf /l/ /ee/ /f/

flower /f/ /l/ /ow/ /er/

street /s/ /t/ /r/ /ee/ /t/
