A. Competing Voices

- ◆ The Holy Spirit has taken up residence in every follower of Jesus.
 - Eph 5:18, Joel 2:28-29 We are commanded to be filled!
- ◆ The devil is a created being, muttering in our heads.
- ◆ We should decide to follow one voice. It can be helpful to repent of following the wrong one.

- ◆ 1 John 3 & 4 paints a picture
- ◆ 1 Cor 13:4
 - Be compassionate, not insecure

- We build up & encourage
- We are truthful

D. The sensitivity issue

No matter how passionately we may be convinced of what the Lord may be saying, we **MUST be sensitive to the prayee's situation.**

E. Types of intervention in prayer

- ◆ Asking the kind Father Matt 6:9-13
- ◆ Asking the friend for help Luke 11:5 – 8
- ◆ Asking for a judgement Luke 18: 1-8
- ◆ Decree or proclaim Job 22:28
- ◆ Prophecy Rev 19:10
- ◆ A word on Discernment Prov 2: 1-5
