## D. The sensitivity issue

No matter how passionately we may be convinced of what the Lord may be saying, we **MUST** be sensitive to the prayee's situation.

- Asking the kind Father Matt 6:9-13
- Asking the friend for help Luke 11:5 – 8
- Asking for a judgement Luke 18: 1-8
- Decree or proclaim Job 22:28
- Prophecy Rev 19:10
- A word on Discernment Prov 2: 1-5
