2 Days Perth to Margaret River Itinerary

Here's a **2-day Perth to Margaret River trip itinerary** focused on **family-friendly hiking, waterfalls, nature, and exploration** — perfect for outdoor lovers with a moderate pace.

Trip Overview

- **Starting Point:** Perth, WA
- **Destination:** Margaret River Region
- **Duration:** 2 Days / 1 Night
- **Focus:** Waterfalls, forest walks, beaches, and local experiences
- **Ideal For:** Families with kids (school-age or older)

Day 1: Perth → Margaret River (via Bunbury and Beedelup Falls)

Morning

- **6:30 AM** – Depart Perth (early to make the most of the day)
- **Optional Stop (2 hrs drive):**
 - **Bunbury Farmers Market** – Great for breakfast, snacks, or picnic supplies (family-friendly and affordable).
- **Drive to Beedelup Falls** (1.5 hrs from Bunbury)


Late Morning – Beedelup Falls

- Located near Pemberton (yes, a detour, but worth it if you want a *real* waterfall)
- Short 300m walk to the falls, longer trails available through **karri forest**
- Suspension bridge = fun for kids

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 Tip: Pack lunch and enjoy a picnic in the area.

Afternoon – Head to Margaret River (1.5 hrs drive)

- Check in to accommodation (family cabin, Airbnb, or holiday park)
- Optional visit: **Margaret River Chocolate Company** or **Cheeky Monkey Brewery** (kid-friendly)

Evening

- Sunset at **Surfers Point** (Prevelly) – wide views, safe open space for kids
- Dinner in Margaret River town (Swings & Roundabouts Pizza or Settlers Tavern)

Day 2: Margaret River → Perth (via Waterfalls & Walks)

Morning – Boranup Forest & Hamelin Bay

- **Boranup Forest Drive:** Scenic drive under towering karri trees
- **Optional Walk:** Boranup Lookout or small forest trails (flat and family-friendly)
- **Hamelin Bay:** Walk on the beach and see the wild stingrays in shallow waters (great for kids)

Midday – Waterfall & Nature Walk

- **Meekadarabee Falls (Ellensbrook)** – A small but charming family-accessible waterfall
 - Short 1.4km return walk
 - Combine with a visit to the **Ellensbrook Homestead** (Aboriginal + settler history)

Lunch

- Picnic at **Leeuwin-Naturaliste National Park** OR lunch in Cowaramup (Candy Cow for kids!)

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Optional Afternoon Hike (if time & energy allows)

- **Cape to Cape Track (Short Segment)**
 - Try **Gracetown to Ellensbrook** section for a scenic 2-3km walk
 - Coastal cliffs, wildflowers, and possible whale spotting (Aug–Nov)

Drive Back to Perth

- Depart around 3:30–4:00 PM
- Arrive in Perth around 7:30 PM

What to Bring

- Walking shoes / hiking boots (some trails may be muddy or rocky)
- Rain jackets (weather can be changeable)
- Reusable water bottles and snacks
- Hat, sunscreen, insect repellent
- Swimsuits + towels (if planning to wade/swim at Hamelin Bay or waterfalls)
- Picnic gear

Suggested Family-Friendly Accommodation (Margaret River)

- **RAC Margaret River Nature Park** (cabins & glamping, forest setting)
- **Margaret River Tourist Park**
- **Airbnb** – search for family units or chalets near town or Prevelly

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
