- 🔝 Sales + Analytics


#### Step 2: Set Up Your Accounts

- Create free accounts on ChatGPT, Canva, Gumroad, and Notion (links above)

#### What Is It?

You'll use ChatGPT to generate content and Canva to design the product. Then, you'll upload it to Gumroad, set your price, and promote it using free traffic (like TikTok, Reddit, or Instagram). This is a great first method because:

- It requires no tech skills
- You don't need to take payments manually Gumroad handles everything
- You create it once, and it can earn money repeatedly (passive income)

#### **Real Product Examples:**



#### Step 1: Choose a Niche

Don't try to sell to "everyone". Pick a niche where people want help getting organised or saving time. Great beginner-friendly niches:

- · Productivity (planners, trackers, routines)
- · Wellness/self-care (journals, challenges)
- · Career (CVs, interview prep, templates)
- · Creators (content calendars, idea banks)
- · Small business (invoicing tools, checklists)

#### Ask ChatGPT —

"Give me 10 digital product ideas for people trying to be more productive" or

"What kind of printable planners are popular with small business owners?"

#### Step 2: Use ChatGPT to Generate the Content

Once you've picked a niche and product idea, use ChatGPT to write the content.

#### Example:

You're making a 30-Day Habit Tracker.

#### Prompt:

"Create a 30-day habit tracker with 1 simple daily goal per day. Keep it motivating and short. Include a title and short description for each day."

You can also ask it to:

- · Write intro text
- Suggest bonus ideas
- · Rephrase or simplify things you've written yourself

#### Step 3: Design Your Product in Canva

- 1. Go to canva.com and create a free account.
- 2. Click "Create a design" > A4 document or Letter (standard printable size).
- 3. Use Canva's drag-and-drop interface to:
  - Add headings, subheadings, and content from ChatGPT
  - · Use their free shapes, icons, and fonts to style it
  - Add page numbers, a simple cover page, or usage instructions
- 4. When you're done, click "Download" > PDF (Print)

#### Step 4: Upload to Gumroad and Set the Price

- 1. Go to gumroad.com and create a free account
- 2. Click "New Product" and choose Digital Product
- 3. Upload your PDF file
- 4. Title your product something specific and benefit-driven
- 5. Example: "30-Day Productivity Challenge (Printable Tracker)"
- 6. Set a price between £4-£9
- 7. Write a clear, short description that explains:
  - What's inside
  - Who it's for
  - · The result it helps them get

Then click Publish — your product is live.

#### Step 5: Promote Using Free Traffic

get it in front of people. You don't need a big audience. You just need a smart approach.

#### 3 ways to start:

- 1. TikTok or Instagram Reels
  - Film a 15-second video showing your planner
  - Use captions like: "This free AI tool helped me make this tracker in a weekend now I sell it for £7"
  - · Link to your Gumroad in bio
- 2. Reddit Value Posts
  - Find subreddits like r/Productivity, r/Notion, r/SideHustle
  - Write a helpful post, e.g. "I made a 30-day self-care tracker using ChatGPT + Canva. Happy to share if anyone wants to try it."
  - Don't be spammy focus on helping
- 3. Gumroad Discovery
  - Add strong tags and a clean thumbnail
  - Your product can show up in Gumroad's internal search

#### Pro Tip: Reuse Your Product

Once you've made one product:

- Turn it into a Notion version and sell that separately
- · Bundle it with another planner
- Offer a bonus (e.g. "Get my free 'Al Tools List' when you buy")

This is how you go from £7 sales to £200/month with just a few products.


#### What Is It?

You'll use ChatGPT to generate valuable prompt packs or how-to guides that solve problems for a specific type of person — then package that content into a PDF or Notion doc and sell it. Examples:

- "100 ChatGPT Prompts for Content Creators" £7
- "The Al Instagram Caption Toolkit" £5
- "Prompt Pack: Launch Your Etsy Shop with AI" £6
- "Al-Powered Resume Kit" £9
- "50 Prompts to Start a Business with ChatGPT" £4

People will pay for clarity, shortcuts, and confidence — even if the tools are free.

#### Step 1: Pick a Niche

You don't need to be an expert — you just need to be clear on who you're helping.

Prompt packs and guides sell best when they're built for:

- Content creators (Instagram, TikTok, YouTube)
- Entrepreneurs (Etsy sellers, coaches, freelancers)
- Job seekers (CV help, interview prep)
- Writers and bloggers
- Students or teachers

Tip: Niche down further — "Al prompts for Etsy shop owners" is way more valuable than "Generic Al prompts for business."

#### Ask ChatGPT:

"What are 10 niche audiences that would benefit from Al-generated prompts?"

#### Step 2: Generate the Prompts or Guide Content

Once you've chosen a niche, it's time to create the content.

Let's say you're creating a Prompt Pack for Freelancers.

#### **Prompt**

"Create 25 ChatGPT prompts to help freelancers write better client proposals, bios, and sales pages. Make them easy to copy and paste."

ChatGPT will instantly give you usable content. You can:

- Edit or improve the results
- Test the prompts yourself to ensure quality
- · Add short tips or explanations if needed

Optional: Add value by grouping prompts into categories (e.g. "Email Templates", "Social Media Content", "Website Copy").

#### Step 3: Package the Product

You have two easy options:

- 1. PDF (via Canva or Google Docs):
  - Clean layout, basic formatting, headings and subheadings
  - Export as a downloadable PDF
- 2. Notion Template:
  - Create a free Notion page with headings, copyable prompts, and usage tips
  - Click "Share" > "Duplicate" to allow buyers to copy it
  - Sell the Notion link as a digital product on Gumroad

#### Step 4: Upload and Sell on Gumroad

Same steps as before:

- 1. Go to gumroad.com
- 2. Upload your PDF or Notion link in a text file
- 3. Add a product title like:
- 4. "25 Al Prompts to Level Up Your Freelance Game"
- 5. Set a price between £4-£9
- 6. Add a short, benefit-driven description like:
- 7. "Struggling to write client proposals or bios? This pack gives you plug-and-play prompts to get clear, confident results from ChatGPT fast."

#### Step 5: Promote with Smart, Free Strategies

- 1. TikTok/Instagram Reels
  - Show how a single prompt works in real time
  - Example caption: "This AI prompt got me a freelance client reply in under 10 minutes"

#### 2. Reddit

- Subreddits like r/Freelance, r/SideHustle, r/Notion, r/Altools
- Share your pack as a tool you made for the community:
- "I made a prompt pack for freelancers that helps with proposals and bios happy to share if it helps anyone here."

#### 3. Facebook Groups

- Join niche groups (e.g. "Social Media Managers UK" or "Al for Creators")
- Share a value-first post, then offer the pack:
- "I created 25 prompts that help me write client content 3x faster. Let me know if you want the link."

#### Bonus Tip: Tailor Packs to Specific Groups

You can sell the same core prompts, repackaged for different groups:

- "25 AI Prompts for Freelance Writers"
- "25 Al Prompts for Etsy Sellers"
- "25 Al Prompts for Job Seekers"

ChatGPT does the heavy lifting — you just need to tweak the framing.

You don't need 100 products. You need 1 product that solves 1 problem for 1 type of person — over and over again.

## METHOD #3: AI FREELANCE SERVICES ON FIVER OR UPWORK

IF YOU'VE EVER WANTED TO OFFER A SERVICE ONLINE — BUT THOUGHT YOU WEREN'T "SKILLED ENOUGH" — THIS IS THE METHOD FOR YOU.

#### What Is It?

You'll create a basic service offering (called a "gig" on Fiverr or a "project" on Upwork), and use ChatGPT to generate or enhance the content your client needs.

Examples of what you can sell:

- CV/resume rewriting £20
- LinkedIn bio writing £15
- Blog post writing (500-1,000 words) £25
- Product descriptions £10
- Email newsletter content £20

These services are in constant demand, and most clients don't care how you do it — they just want clean, useful results.



## **METHOD #3: STEP BY STEP GUIDE**

#### Step 1: Choose a Simple, Repeatable Service

You want a service that:

- · You can deliver quickly with Al
- Doesn't require specialist knowledge or credentials
- Solves a real problem for the buyer

#### Ideal beginner services:

- CV/resume improvements
- Cover letters
- Personal bios
- Blog writing for small businesses
- Social media captions or product listings
- Ask ChatGPT for ideas:

"What freelance writing services are most in demand on Fiverr and Upwork?"

#### Step 2: Create a Gig on Fiverr or Upwork

#### On Fiverr:

- 1.Go to fiverr.com, create an account
- 2. Click "Become a Seller"
- 3. Create your gig:
  - Title: "I will write a professional bio using AI"
  - Description: Focus on outcomes e.g. "You'll get a clear, well-written bio optimised for LinkedIn or websites."
  - Delivery time: 1–2 days
  - Price: Start low (£5-£15) to build reviews quickly

#### On Upwork:

- 1. Go to <u>upwork.com</u>, create a free account
- 2. Complete your profile use a friendly, honest tone
- 3. Search for relevant jobs and submit proposals manually
  - Use ChatGPT to help write your proposals too

#### Bonus: Use AI to write your own Fiverr or Upwork profile bio.

#### Prompt

"Write a friendly and confident freelance bio for someone who offers resume rewrites and blog writing using ChatGPT."

## **METHOD #3: STEP BY STEP GUIDE**

#### Step 3: Use ChatGPT to Deliver Quality Work — Fast

Once you land your first client, don't panic — Al has your back.

#### **Examples:**

- · Client asks for a blog post on "5 ways to stay productive while working remotely"
- Prompt: "Write a 500-word blog post in a friendly tone on 5 ways to stay productive while working from home. Include bullet points and a short intro."
- · Client asks for a professional CV rewrite
- Prompt: "Improve this CV bullet point: 'Worked in customer service answering phones and emails.' Make it more professional and achievement-focused."

#### You can then:

- · Tweak the output manually
- Run it through Grammarly for polish (free)
- · Deliver it in a clean Google Doc or Word file

Tip: Always edit slightly — don't deliver raw Al content. Clients value a human touch.

#### Step 4: Build Reviews & Raise Your Rates

When you're new, your #1 goal is to get good reviews.

#### How:

- · Deliver early and overdeliver on quality
- Add a bonus ("I've also written a short version of your CV for LinkedIn")
- · Thank the client and kindly ask for a review once the job is complete

After 3–5 solid reviews, increase your price.

This is how you go from £10 per job to £50+ per job without working harder — just smarter.

Clients love seeing samples.

Even if you're new, you can create mock examples using ChatGPT and display them as your portfolio.

#### Steps:

- 1. Open <u>notion.so</u> and create a free account
- 2. Create a page called "Freelance Writing Portfolio"
- 3. Add sections like:
  - Sample CV rewrite
  - Sample blog post
  - Sample bio or product description
- 4. Click "Share" and enable public access
- 5. Add that link to your Fiverr or Upwork profile

#### Prompt:

"Write a 300-word blog post about how AI is changing small business marketing — friendly, helpful tone"

## REALISTIC RESULTS: WHAT YOU CAN EXPECT

If you offer simple services like blog posts, CV rewrites, or bios using ChatGPT, here's what a realistic side hustle looks like:

- . 5 small jobs per week at £20 each
- = £100/week
- . → £400/month

That's money you can earn in your spare time — evenings, weekends, or lunch breaks. Simple Work, Steady Growth

Each job takes around 30–60 minutes using AI to speed up writing and editing. Once you've built a few reviews, you can:

Good news — you don't need to pay for ads, hire marketers, or go viral. You just need to show up consistently where people are already looking.

#### 1. TikTok & Instagram Reels

Why it works: Short-form video is still king. And you don't need to show your face if you don't want to.

#### What to post:

- Behind the scenes: "I used AI to build this product here's how"
- Quick wins: "This ChatGPT prompt helped me make £40 this week"
- Demo videos: Flip through your planner, prompt pack, or CV rewrite

#### Tools you'll use:

- · CapCut (free) For editing videos and adding captions automatically
- · ChatGPT To write video scripts and captions

#### **Example Script (prompt ChatGPT with):**

"Write a 20-second TikTok script about how I created a £5 digital planner with AI tools"

Pro Tip: Add text over your video like:

"Made this in Canva using ChatGPT – now I sell it for £7"

Link to your Gumroad in bio and post 2–3 times a week.

2. Reddit Value Posts

Why it works: Reddit users don't want sales pitches — they want help. If you offer genuine value first, they'll often ask for your product.

How to do it:

1. Join 2–3 relevant subreddits like:

- r/SideHustle
- r/Altools
- r/Notion
- r/Productivity
- r/Freelance
- 2. Post a genuine story or lesson, like:
- 3. "I made my first £120 this month using AI and Gumroad. Here's exactly what I did."
- 4. Share tips, and only mention your product at the end or in the comments:
- 5. "Happy to send you the planner I made if you want to check it out just reply or DM me."

This builds trust and real curiosity.

Bonus: Use ChatGPT to help you write your post.

**Prompt:** "Write a Reddit post for r/SideHustle explaining how I made £200 from a prompt pack using ChatGPT and Canva."

#### 3. Micro-Influencer Outreach

Why it works: Instead of trying to get 1,000 followers yourself, borrow someone else's audience. A micro-influencer is anyone with 500–10,000 followers in a niche — and they're usually happy to share useful products (especially if they're free or come with affiliate commission).

#### Step-by-step:

- 1. Make a list of 10–20 micro-creators in your niche
  - E.g. "Al tips", "digital planners", "student productivity", "freelance life"
  - Use Instagram, TikTok, Twitter/X
- 2. Send them a DM or email like this:

#### DM Script:

Hey [Name],

I really enjoy your content around [niche]! I've just made a simple AI-powered resource that helps [target audience] — it's a [prompt pack/planner/guide], and I created it using ChatGPT and Canva. Happy to send you a free copy — if you think it's helpful, feel free to share it with your audience (no pressure at all).

Let me know, and keep up the great posts

– [Your name]

Even if 2 out of 20 say yes, you've just tapped into a ready-made audience without paying for ads. **Bonus:** Offer them a free affiliate code using Gumroad (they earn 30–50% per sale).

## HOW TO SCALE BEYOND £200/MONTH

THIS IS WHERE THINGS START TO GET EXCITING. ONCE YOU'VE PROVEN THAT SOMEONE WILL PAY YOU, YOU CAN BEGIN TO SCALE THAT EFFORT INTO SOMETHING BIGGER. NOT BY WORKING 10X HARDER, BUT BY REPACKAGING, AUTOMATING, AND STACKING VALUE..

#### 1. Turn Your Best Product Into a Mini Course

If you've created something that sells — like a planner, prompt pack or freelance service — you already have the core of a course.

People love:

- Tutorials
- · Walkthroughs
- Templates
- · "How I did it" videos

You don't need to be an expert. You just need to be 1 or 2 steps ahead of someone who hasn't started.

Let's say your planner sold well. Turn it into a mini course like:

"How I Made a £7 Digital Planner with ChatGPT & Canva (In One Weekend)"

- Sell it for £19–£47 as an upsell

Tip: If filming video isn't your thing, write it as a step-by-step PDF guide instead.

#### 2. Start an Email List

If you're not collecting emails, you're leaving money on the table.

Building a list means you can:

- · Sell future products without posting on social media
- · Build trust and community
- · Create long-term income from the same buyers
