FIC JOY The Unlikely Pilgrimage of Harold Fry by Rachel Joyce - "A gorgeously poignant novel of hope and transformation."

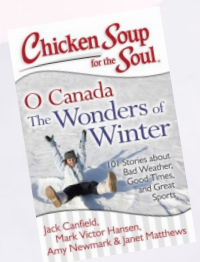

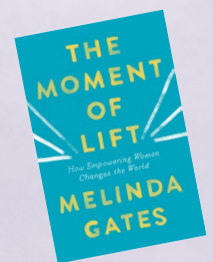

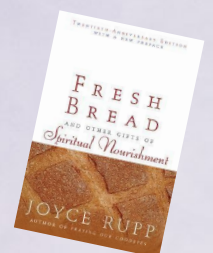
