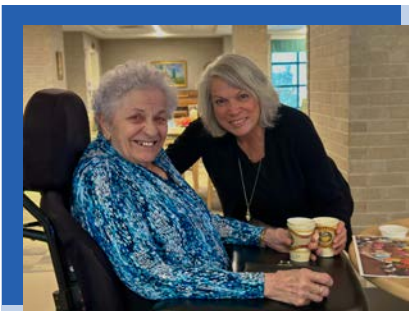
HFH-BUS-STOP-SCOOPS

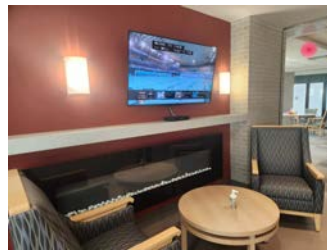
