This year, Father's Day was celebrated in a unique way with special music entertainment, beer, and something salty. Happy Father's Day to all the fathers on Earth and in Heaven.

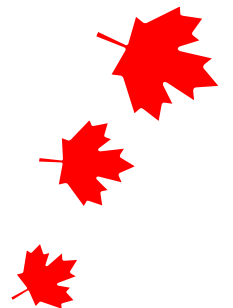

It was truly heartwarming to come together and enjoy the beautiful day. And let's not forget—the ice cream was the highlight of the evening!



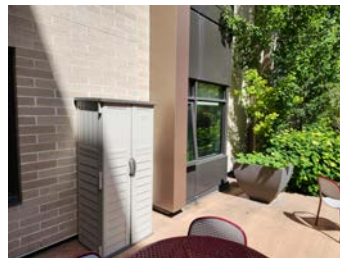
## BBQ FOR STAFF
