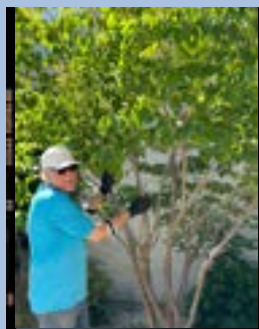

MARY'S GARDEN

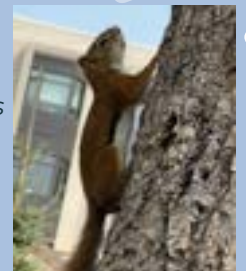
