<p>Interview Format</p> <p>A one-to-one conversation with doctors from different specialties, generations and practice settings.</p>	<p>Doctor's Confession</p> <p>Anonymous or open sharing of real experiences, emotional struggles, dilemmas, failures, lessons and turning points.</p>
<p>Unspoken Words</p> <p>Doctors express what they often feel but rarely say publicly.</p>	<p>Group Discussion</p> <p>Panel-style discussion on one professional issue involving 3 to 5 doctors.</p>
<p>Young Doctor's Voice</p> <p>A special space for interns, residents, DNB students and early-career doctors.</p>	<p>Senior Doctor's Reflection</p> <p>Experienced doctors share wisdom, mistakes, memories, lessons and messages for the next generation.</p>
<p>Problem-Solution Clinic</p> <p>A focused discussion on one practical issue and its possible solutions.</p>	<p>Doctors Beyond Prescription</p> <p>A discussion on doctors as educators, mentors, speakers, writers, leaders and health reformers.</p>
