- Reserve Certification Preferred but will train
- High School Diploma or GED
- No felony convictions
- No convictions for crimes of moral turpitude or domestic violence
- Be able to work in a small town
- Have highly principled ethics and moral character
- Have excellent communication skills and highly self-motivated

The Wellston Police Department does compensate Reserve officers once certified. While at least a Reserve Certification is desired to start working at the time of commission; we do offer the opportunity to a start a career in law enforcement.
