




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



TRANSLATION

- **96:1.** Recite with the name of your Lord Who created
- 96:2. Created man from a clinging clot
- 96:3. Recite, for your Lord is the Most Generous
- 96:4. Who taught the use of the pen
- 96:5. Taught man what he knew not



TAFSEER

This is a command to the Prophet to recite what would be revealed to him of the Qur'an, commencing with the name of Allah by saying Bismillah-ir-Rahman-ir-Raheem - In the name of Allah, the Most Gracious, the Most Merciful. This surah was the first surah of the Qur'an to be revealed to the Messenger of Allah . It was revealed to him at the beginning of his

prophethood, when he did not know anything about the Book or about faith. Jibreel came to him with the message and commanded him to recite, but he refused, saying, "I am not a reciter." (Bukhari)



But Jibreel kept urging him until he recited.


Then Allah ** revealed to him the words:

"Recite [commencing] with the name of your Lord Who created (all of creation)".

Then He singles out man and mentions the beginning of his creation, "from a clinging clot". The One Who created man and cared for him must also care for him by issuing commands and prohibitions, which He did by sending the Messenger to them and sending down the Books to them.

Hence after the command to recite, He mentions His creation of man. Then He says: "Recite, for your Lord is the Most Generous"

that is, He is possessed of the most sublime attributes and is very generous and kind. Part of His kindness is that He taught the use of the pen, "Who taught the use of the pen, taught man what he knew not" for He brought him forth from his mother's womb not knowing anything, and He gave him hearing, sight and intellect, and made available to him the means of acquiring knowledge.




So He taught him the Qur'an, and He taught him wisdom, and He taught him the use of the pen, through which knowledge is preserved and rights and duties are regulated, and messages are

exchanged between people so that they do not have to speak directly to one another.

All praise be to Allah , Who has bestowed these blessings upon His slaves, for which they cannot give sufficient thanks. Moreover He has blessed them with independence of means and abundant provision.



HISTORY AT A GLANCE

ABU BAKR'S FINAL INSTRUCTIONS TO UMAR The History of Islam, Vol. 1, Page 322

Abu Bakr on the day he died, had issued the following instructions to Umar after the arrival of Muthanna on 22nd of Jumada Al-Ukhra, 13 AH, and hearing from him the account of affairs:



"I am sure to pass away today. Thus, you (Umar) will dispatch Muthanna for fighting tomorrow before the end of the day. No suffering whatsoever should hold you back

from carrying out the religious tasks and the Commands of Allah the Almighty. You have seen what I did after the death of the Prophet even though it was the greatest calamity for us. When the Syrians are conquered, make it a point to send back the Iraqis to Iraq for they know their own business very well and they are at ease only in Iraq."

The above words make it amply clear that from the day the Prophet made his final departure to the day of his own last journey, every moment of his life was devoted to Divine duties. He made no will concerning his wives and children.

- He was born in Makkah, and his original name was Abdullah bin Uthman
- His father's name was Abu Quhafah Uthman bin Aamir, and his mother's name was Umm ul-Khair Salmah bint Sakhr
- He had 4 wives and 6 children (3 sons and 3

daughters)



- Abdullah bin Abu Bakr

- Abdur Rahman bin Abu Bakr

- He had deep knowledge of Arab tribes and their genealogies (family trees)
- He was 2 years younger than the Prophet sand was a successful merchant
- He was the closest friend of the Prophet sand the first man to embrace Islam
- He used to buy newly converted Muslim slaves and set them free with his wealth


- He had the honor of migrating to Madinah with the Prophet
- He was with the Prophet in the Cave of Thawr and was the most courageous and knowledgeable among all the companions
- His daughter Aisha was married to the Prophet
 making him the father-in-law of the Prophet
- He participated in all the battles alongside the Prophet
- During the last days of the Prophet ﷺ, he led the people in prayer as the Imam
- He became the first Caliph of the Muslims and was given the title Khalifat-ur-Rasulullah
- As Caliph, he led the Muslims for 2 years and 3 months
- During his caliphate, he crushed a major rebellion known as the Fitnah of Apostasy (Irtidad), which means leaving Islam



- In his time, the false prophet Musailamah
 Al-Kazzab (the Liar) was killed.
- He was the first among the 10 companions who were given the glad tidings of Paradise during their lifetime



COMMON MISTAKES IN SALAH

THE MAGNIFYING GLASS ON CLARIFYING MANY COMMON ERRORS

- 1 Leaving the salaah altogether. This is indeed kufr (disbelief).
- **2** Delaying the salaah from its appointed time.
- Abandonment of the congregational prayer in the masjid by able men either regularly or on occasion.


COMMON MISTAKES IN SALAH

- Lack of tranquility within the salaah. This is generally done out of ignorance and it is an open sin because tranquility is a pillar (rukn) of the salaah without which the salaah is incorrect.
- Lack of proper reverence and humility (khushoo') in the salaah and excess movement therein.
- following his movements.
- 7 Standing to complete a missed rak'ah before the imaam has completely finished making the second tasleem.
- 8 Making the intention for prayer aloud. This is a bid'ah (innovation).

COMMON MISTAKES IN SALAH

- Not reciting Al-Faatihah in the salaah.
 The recitation of Al-Faatihah is a pillar (rukn) and the salaah of whoever does not recite it is void.
- Recitation of the Qur'aan in rukoo' (bowing position) or during sujood (prostration). This is prohibited.


