As we have been introducing our new service times, I have been going back and forth on how to describe what makes each of our churches and their services special. I have used words like 'traditional' and 'contemporary'. The truth of course is that all our services are a mix of traditional and contemporary: the liturgy that we follow has roots in the ancient church, while the sermon brings in present-day concerns. Some of the hymns we sing are centuries old, while others were written in the last few decades. Little has changed in the last few weeks other than what time the services take place. The service in East Hendred has been relatively 'contemporary' since long before my time, addressing God as 'you' rather than the more traditional 'thee/thou' used elsewhere in the benefice. Both are authentic and respectful ways of revering our creator.

In past sessions we have tackled questions like when the first homo sapiens began to have souls, and whether churches' doctrinal statements are important.
