

Yesterday I went and had dinner at LOS TORROS in Chatsworth, for my first time. As I entered and walked around, the various dining rooms, I was swept back in time 100 years

- Outside before you enter, you see huge but charming planters built into the sidewalk.
- Among the plants and ivy on the walls, you see numerous Spanish tile art pieces, of historic subjects & holy images, of a type that you rarely seen outside Santa Barbara or Olvera Street.
- I discovered a huge spread out restaurant, with numerous dinning rooms and a huge, square, covered, all weather patio for dining or banquets. The patio alone provably seats nearly 200.
- The whole staff looked very cheerful in their Christmas Sweaters.
- Inside, some walls are brightly decorated with contrasting Spanish tiles. The larger rooms are furnished in an old mission style.
- The BAR looks like a fun place to hang out and there are several tables about the room.

The Los Toros menu has FOUR FULL pages, offering a large variety of choices,

Many hearty Traditional dishes like Chile Colorado and Chile Verde, Chicken & Mole. You can choose from Beef, Chicken, Fish, Sea Food & Vegetarian meals.

Some beef Dishes are Sautéed with vegetables, like my wonderful dinner called “JALISCO”, also called “STEAK RANCHERO”, It has slices of Beef, bell peppers, tomato and onion with a touch of tomato sauce, plus it comes with rice, beans, guacamole & tortillas

We were also served a delicious plate of “CAMARONES AL LA DIABLA”, Shrimp in a medium spicy chipotle sauce, served with a Julienne of sautéed zucchini and carrots

Los Toros also offers many of the standard selections, like Tacos Enchiladas, Burritos and Tamales. You can have them à la carte, in dinner size and in group portions for 2, 4, 6 guests etc. That makes it very easy to order for family groups, especially for those with kids.

Los Toros also offers 8 VEGAN Dishes on the menu.

They also offer Mexican Breakfast dishes like chilaquiles, huevos rancheros etc

They also offer SALADS, what they call BELLY BUSTER, and deserts

They served a great Margarita.
