This week we visited POZOLERIA DONA ANA, in Panorama City.

- POZOLERIA DONA ANA, is a Family owned and operated Mexican Soup Restaurant, specializing in authentic Menudo, Birria and POZOLE.
- Cinthia Hernandez, the GM serves food, coaches to the cooks, sings Happy Birthday to the guests as needed, and tells the history of the family restaurant.
- POZOLERIA DONA ANA, started as a sidewalk food stand for its first 3 years then it opened three years ago as a restaurant on Nordoff St, in Panorama City.
- Walking in, you notice friendly workers behind the counter, cooks serving soups and a dozen tables with happy people enjoying their meals.
- There are large windows on two sides, & a partition wall is colorfully decorated and conceals a larger a kitchen.

Lets talk abut food,

- The BEEF POZOLE was perfect, Lots of shredded beef, hominy and broth. The broth was just right, in its red color & taste.
- The condiments of chopped onion, cilantro, lime wedges, dry chile, & oregano, were at my finger tips and added even more flavor to the soup.

- All the soups are SERVED IN A METAL POT with a LID, and all the other diners seemed to be happy to enjoy pots of soup as much as I was.
- Another item is Special, The QUESO TACO was wonderful, filled with shredded beef and cheese. It is like a semi-crispy quesadilla fried with oil and some red chile sauce. It is Only \$2.50 on Tuesdays.
- Look! They had 600+ pre-orders for Christmas Eve. They sure are doing more than something right.

Service is very attentive especially from owner Cinthia, her daughter & her sister.

They do a large amount of carry out business.

Over all it is a good place to get very Good Mexican food for those who know the real thing, and for those who want to learn more about the real thing.

So if you are in the areas of Panorama City, Van Nuys, Mission Hills, North Hills or Arleta, POZOLERIA DONA ANA is very convenient for you to get very good Pozole, Birria, Menudo and other Mexican foods.
