Report of Findings & Recommendations

Presented to HOA Board July 15, 2025

Executive Summary

Mission Statement/Scope: The Beautification Committee was established with the purpose of assessing the needs and evaluating the opportunities to aesthetically enhance common areas defined as: seven rain gardens (RG), main entrance pillars, non-RG parking areas, lower conservation area mulch walking path, two gravel walking paths.

Investigative Resources: CT DEEP, CT North Central Conservation District (licensed arborist), UCONN Nemo, Towns of Plainville/Farmington Inland Wetlands, Bartlett Tree Service (licensed arborist), various websites and YouTube RG videos.

Rain Gardens:

- a. 6:7 considerably overgrown; a challenge to discern native plants from weeds
- b. Complete "cut-down" to perimeter plants and rock basin zones
- c. Clean out inlet/outlet culvert pipes and check for proper pitch
- d. Incorporate additional stone (CT river rock) to rock basin (aka zone 1)
- e. Incorporate additional native plants/trees and mulch (aka zone 2)
- f. Expand grass perimeter and mulch existing trees (aka zone 3)
- g. Priorities: #7, 6, 1, 2, 4, 5
- h. Bartlett advises against treating/spraying diseased trees
- i. Responsibility: TBD/Ali's see site map "maintenance schedule" compliant?
- j. Begin on/about 9/1/25

Main Entrance:

- a. Mulch bed around each pillar (see appendix picture)
- b. Committee can plant annuals Spring/Fall incl. weed, water.
- c. Begin on/about 9/1/25

Non-RG Parking Areas:

- a. Committee recommends grass or ground cover vs. stone
- b. Committee can repair if Ali's provides topsoil and residents agree to water when reseeded
- c. Begin on/about 9/1/25

Lower Conservation Area/Woods Mulch Waling Path:

- a. Committee can maintain
- b. Free mulch available when needed
- c. Maintain as needed

Two Gravel Common Walking Paths:

- a. Opportunity to remove and replace with grass?
- b. Thereby eliminate need for ongoing maintenance?
- c. HOA vote?
