Instruction

Pray this if you have made vows, oaths, dedications, rituals, or spoken agreements connected to sin, occult practice, secret societies, or ungodly allegiances, whether knowingly or unknowingly.

The Prayer

Father God,

I come before You in the name of Jesus Christ. I acknowledge that covenant belongs to You alone.

If I have entered into any covenant, oath, vow, dedication, ritual agreement, or spoken declaration that was not aligned with Your Word, I repent.

Forgive me for any agreement made in ignorance, curiosity, rebellion, or deception. Forgive me for any participation in ceremonies, initiations, secret pledges, or symbolic acts that created spiritual obligation outside of You.

I renounce every ungodly covenant.

I renounce every oath made outside of Christ.

I renounce every spoken agreement that aligned me with darkness.

I renounce every ritual dedication of my body, my future, or my lineage.

If I dedicated myself to anything apart from You, I revoke it now in the name of Jesus Christ.

Your Word declares that Christ has redeemed me from every curse. Through His finished work, every unlawful spiritual claim is canceled.

I declare that no vow made in darkness has authority over me. No agreement formed outside of Christ stands.

I break every ungodly covenant by the authority of Jesus Christ. I sever every spiritual tie formed through deception or rebellion.

I dedicate myself fully and exclusively to the Lord.

My life belongs to Jesus Christ. My future belongs to Jesus Christ. My covenant is with God alone.

Closing Declaration
