Instruction

Pray this if you feel unsettled, pressured, or spiritually drained. Begin with submission before seeking peace.

The Prayer

Father God,

I come before You in the name of Jesus Christ. I acknowledge that You are my refuge and my strength.

If I have felt spiritual pressure, heaviness, confusion, or opposition, I bring it before You now.

First, I submit myself to You. I examine my heart. If there is any compromise, correct me. If there is any open door, reveal it.

Now I resist every influence that seeks to disturb my peace.

Your Word promises perfect peace to those whose minds are stayed on You. I choose to fix my mind on truth.

I reject fear. I reject anxiety. I reject confusion.

Peace is not emotional calm alone. Peace is alignment with Christ.

Guard my heart. Guard my thoughts. Stabilize my emotions.

Let the peace of God stand watch over my mind.

I will not dwell in turmoil. I will not magnify opposition. I will magnify the Lord.

Jesus Christ is my defender. I rest in Him.
