Instruction

If cultural pressures, negative influences, or confusion attempt to shape their thinking, give me wisdom to address it clearly.

Help me establish a home where truth is taught consistently and where questions can be asked honestly.

If patterns of instability, absence, or poor parenting existed in my family line, I ask that those patterns stop here.

Teach me to lead my children toward wisdom, responsibility, and reverence for You.

Guide my decisions as a parent so that I raise them with patience, clarity, and love.
