

Prayer of Full Repentance Before Approaching God

Scripture Foundation

Psalm 51:10

“Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a right spirit within me.”

1 John 1:9

“If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.”

Hebrews 4:16

“Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need.”

Instruction

Pray this aloud with sincerity. Repentance is not emotion alone. It is a decision to turn from sin and return fully to God.

The Prayer

Father God,

I come before You in the name of Jesus Christ. Before I ask for anything, before I speak against any opposition, I first humble myself before You.

I acknowledge that You are holy. You are righteous. You are just. And I confess that I have sinned in thought, in word, and in action.

Search me, Lord. Reveal to me anything in my heart that is not pleasing to You. If I have participated in pride, rebellion, unforgiveness, sexual sin, idolatry, fear, occult practices, compromise, or spiritual laziness, I confess it now.

I do not excuse it. I do not justify it. I turn away from it.

Forgive me for every known and unknown sin. Forgive me for anything I entertained that grieved Your Spirit. Forgive me for any agreement I made with darkness, knowingly or unknowingly.

Wash me in the blood of Jesus Christ.

Create in me a clean heart and renew a right spirit within me. Remove hardness. Remove deception. Remove double-mindedness. I surrender fully to You.

I renounce every sin that separated me from fellowship with You. I renounce every hidden compromise. I renounce anything that gave the enemy access in my life.

Jesus, You are Lord. Not my emotions. Not my desires. Not culture. Not influence. You alone.

Restore my fellowship with You. Restore clarity. Restore conviction. Restore peace.

I choose obedience. I choose holiness. I choose truth.

Thank You for mercy. Thank You for forgiveness. Thank You for receiving me as I return.
