Ephesians 6:10–11

“Be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might. Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil.”

James 4:7

“Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.”

Instruction

Pray this daily as an act of submission and obedience. The armor of God is not a ritual. It is a posture of alignment with truth.

The Prayer

Father God,

I come before You in the name of Jesus Christ. Your Word tells me to be strong in the Lord and in the power of Your might. Today, I choose to stand in that strength.

I submit myself fully to You. I surrender my thoughts, my motives, my decisions, and my actions to Your authority.

I put on the belt of truth. Let Your Word govern my thinking. Expose deception and anchor me in what is right.

I put on the breastplate of righteousness. Guard my heart from accusation, condemnation, and compromise. Let my life reflect obedience.

I put on the shoes of the preparation of the gospel of peace. Establish stability in my steps. Let peace guide my responses.

I take up the shield of faith. When doubt, fear, or accusation arises, I trust in Your promises.

I receive the helmet of salvation. Guard my mind from confusion and despair. Remind me that I belong to Christ.

I take up the sword of the Spirit, which is the Word of God. Teach me to speak Scripture with humility and confidence.

I do not fight in my own strength. I stand under the authority of Jesus Christ.

If opposition arises, I will remain obedient. If pressure increases, I will remain grounded in truth.

You are my defender. You are my protection. You are my covering.
