


10 games to play with rhythm cards:

<p>1. Copycat</p> <p>One player plays a card but keeps it hidden. The other plays back what they heard.</p>	<p>2. Catch the Click</p> <p>Lay out 2-3 cards on the stand. Play them with the metronome. Try it at 3 different speeds.</p>
<p>3. Play by Numbers</p> <p>Choose 3 numbers from 1-5. Pick a rhythm card and play it on each finger numbered.</p>	<p>4. Rhythm Duets</p> <p>Choose 2 rhythm cards and play them at the same time, like a duet. Then swap parts.</p>
<p>5. Lineup</p> <p>Lay out 3-4 rhythm cards. One person plays one of them, and the other picks the card they heard.</p>	<p>6. Tiny Song</p> <p>Choose 3 notes and a rhythm card. Play the rhythm on each note, with no gaps. Sing along!</p>
<p>7. Swap & Flip</p> <p>Lay out 3-4 cards. Play them all together. Then swap the order, and turn one upside-down.</p>	<p>8. One Man Band</p> <p>Play different cards on different instruments - 2 chopsticks or a saucepan and spoon works!</p>
<p>9. Word Play</p> <p>Choose 3-4 note letters that spell a word. Play a rhythm card on each of the 3 notes, with no gap.</p>	<p>10. Silent Snap</p> <p>2 players play 2 rhythm cards with a 4 beat rest between. Count the rest silently and come in together.</p>
