

MEMORANDUM OF COOPERATION

between:

The Esports Federation of Serbia and Double T e-sports

Contracting Parties

Article 1

This Memorandum of Cooperation (hereinafter: the “Memorandum”) is concluded between:

- **Esports Federation of Serbia**, with its registered seat in Belgrade (hereinafter: the “Federation”), and
- **Double T e-sports**, with its registered seat in Tutin (hereinafter: the “Partner”).

The Federation and the Partner shall hereinafter be jointly referred to as the “Parties”.

Article 2

Subject of the Memorandum

The subject of this Memorandum is the establishment of a framework for cooperation between the Parties for the purpose of developing, promoting, and improving esports, gaming culture, and digital competitions, as well as the implementation of joint projects, events, and activities of mutual interest.

Article 3

Areas of Cooperation

The Parties mutually agree that their cooperation shall include, but not be limited to, the following areas:

- joint organization of esports and gaming events, tournaments, and leagues;
 - promotion of esports and digital sports through online and offline channels;
 - creation and distribution of joint media and promotional content;
 - cooperation on educational, developmental, and socially responsible projects;
 - mutual support in the promotion of brands, activities, and initiatives;
 - exchange of knowledge, experience, and resources in accordance with the capabilities of the Parties.

Article 3a

Achieved Results and International Representation

The Parties acknowledge that during 2025, Double T e-sports achieved notable and successful results in domestic and international esports competitions, thereby making a significant contribution to the development and promotion of the esports scene of the Republic of Serbia.

The Parties further mutually confirm that the team representing Double T e-sports, within the framework of the cooperation defined by this Memorandum and in accordance with the applicable rules and regulations of the competent international and national organizations, shall represent the national team of the Republic of Serbia at an international competition to be held in Astana, Republic of Kazakhstan, during 2026, in the **Phygital Shooters** discipline.

This provision is of a promotional and declarative nature and does not constitute the assumption of additional financial or legally binding obligations by the Parties, unless otherwise regulated by a separate agreement or annex.

Article 4

Principles of Cooperation

The cooperation between the Parties shall be based on the principles of:

- equality and mutual respect;
- transparency and professionalism;
- compliance with the applicable laws of the Republic of Serbia;
- protection of the reputation and goodwill of both Parties.

Article 5

Financial Aspects

This Memorandum does not create any financial obligations. Any potential financial relations, rights, and obligations shall be regulated by separate agreements or annexes, depending on the specific projects and activities.

Article 6

Duration of the Memorandum

This Memorandum is concluded for an indefinite period and shall enter into force on the date of signing by the authorized representatives of both Parties.

Either Party may terminate this Memorandum by providing written notice to the other Party, without stating reasons, with a notice period of 30 days.

Article 7

Final Provisions

Any amendments or supplements to this Memorandum shall be made exclusively in writing, with the mutual consent of both Parties.

This Memorandum represents an expression of good faith and intent of the Parties to cooperate and does not create a legally binding relationship, unless otherwise regulated by separate agreements.

This Memorandum is executed in four (4) identical copies, each Party retaining two (2) copies.
