## Curatorial Note

The Fallen Algorithm marks the fracture. Here the fall is not moral spectacle; it is a structural error—an aberration in the logic that was meant to guarantee perfection. The image suggests that what collapses is not “evil,” but certainty: the belief that a system can contain freedom without consequence. The work frames hubris as a technical impulse: control pursued to the point where complexity becomes indistinguishable from collapse.
