Curatorial Note

The Last Confession stages a private ritual in a world where the listener has changed. The work suggests confession without absolution—an admission delivered not to a deity, but to an intelligence that evaluates without empathy. Here, guilt becomes metadata; the self is reduced to a record. The question becomes “accepted or rejected,” and the only witness is a system designed to remember everything.
