Vaccinations

Vaccinations are an important part of your pet's preventative health care. They protect your pet from several serious and potentially fatal diseases. Some vaccines also help prevent diseases that can be passed from animals to people (zoonotic).

Mild vaccine reactions may occur within the first 24–48 hours and can include:

- Mild soreness at the injection site
- Tiredness or decreased activity
- Mild decrease in appetite
- Mild fever

These signs are typically short-lived and self-resolving.

Please contact a veterinarian immediately if your pet develops:

- ***Facial swelling***
 - ***Hives***
 - ***Vomiting or diarrhea***
 - ***Difficulty breathing***
 - ***Severe lethargy/collapse***
 - ***Persistent pain or swelling***

Topical Flea/Tick Preventative

- The application site typically dries within 2 hours but may take up to 48 hours to be unnoticeable.
- Do not bathe or allow swimming for at least 72 hours after application for maximum efficacy.
- Prevent pets from grooming the application site until dry.

Possible side effects may include mild skin irritation, drooling if licked (bitter-tasting), vomiting, diarrhea, or lethargy.

Important for Dog Products

Some canine flea/tick products are **highly toxic to cats**. Keep cats separated from treated dogs until the application site is completely dry.

Deworming Medication

Deworming medications are generally very safe and well tolerated. Mild side effects can include:

- Vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Decreased appetite
- Temporary lethargy

You may notice worms passed in the stool after treatment. This can be normal.

Good hygiene and routine parasite prevention are important to reduce reinfection risk.
